AGREEMENT TO EXTEND THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES NATIONAL AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINSTRATION AND THE **ITALIAN SPACE AGENCY CONCERNING COOPERATION ON THE** GAMMA-RAY LARGE AREA SPACE TELESCOPE MISSION

The United States National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the Italian Space Agency (ASI),

Desiring to continue their cooperation on the 2007 Gamma-Ray Large Area Space Telescope mission, now known as "Fermi," under their Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), entering into force on December 4, 2007, and

Desiring to continue this successful cooperation through the Italian scientific Large Area Tracker hardware and operations expertise,

Hereby agree, in accordance with Article 18.1 of the MOU, to extend the MOU until December 31, 2017, unless further extended by mutual written agreement or terminated in accordance with Article 18.2 of the MOU.
