NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

AGREEMENT AMENDING THE AIR TRANSPORT AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA

The Government of the United States of America and the Government of Jamaica (hereinafter, "the Parties");

Desiring to modernize and strengthen their bilateral aviation relationship and to expand allcargo international air transport opportunities in order to facilitate increased and more efficient commerce and trade;

Have agreed to amend Annex I to the Air Transport Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Jamaica, signed at Kingston on October 30, 2008 ("the Agreement"), as follows:

Article 1

Amendments to Annex I ("Scheduled Air Transportation")

In Annex I to the Agreement:

- 1. Section 1, paragraph A shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - A. Routes for the airline or airlines designated by the Government of the United States:

From points behind the United States via the United States and intermediate points to any point or points in Jamaica and beyond; and for all-cargo service, between Jamaica and any point or points.

- 2. Section 1, paragraph B shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - B. <u>Routes for the airline or airlines designated by the Government of</u> <u>Jamaica</u>:

From points behind Jamaica via Jamaica and intermediate points to any point or points in the United States and beyond; and for all-cargo service, between the United States and any point or points.

3. Section 2 shall be amended by deleting the final clause and replacing it with the following:

without directional or geographic limitation and without loss of any right to carry traffic otherwise permissible under this Agreement; <u>provided</u> that, with the exception of all-cargo services, the service serves a point in the territory of the Party designating the airline.

4. Section 3 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

Section 3

Change of Gauge

On any segment or segments of the routes above, any designated airline may perform international air transportation without any limitation as to change, at any point on the route, in type or number of aircraft operated; <u>provided</u> that, with the exception of all-cargo services, in the outbound direction, the transportation beyond such point is a continuation of the transportation from the territory of the Party that has designated the airline and, in the inbound direction, the transportation to the territory of the Party that has designated the airline is a continuation of the transportation from beyond such point.

<u>Article 2</u>

Entry into Force

This agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature.
