NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

If the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland accepts this proposal, the Department has the further honor to propose that this note and the British Embassy's affirmative note in reply shall constitute an

agreement between the two governments, which shall enter into force on the date of the reply, with effect from September 30, 2022.

together constitute an agreement between the two Governments, which shall enter into force on the date of this reply, with effect from September 30, 2022.

The Embassy of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the United States Department of State the assurances of its highest consideration.
