(Short Title: Amendment One to the Colombia-U.S.
Master Information Exchange Agreement)

PREAMBLE

The Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of National Defense of the Republic of Colombia, hereinafter referred to as the “Parties”;

Considering the Agreement Between the Department of Defense of the United States of America Concerning Exchange of Research and Development Information (Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement), which entered into force July 21, 2009, and remains in force through July 20, 2024;

Have reached the following understandings:

ARTICLE I PURPOSE

- 1.1. The purpose of this Amendment One to the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement is to extend the duration of the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement by fifteen (15) years through July 20, 2039.

ARTICLE II AMENDMENT

2.1. In accordance with paragraph 13.6. of Article XIII (Amendment, Termination, Entry Into Force, and Duration) of the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement, the Parties have consulted and hereby consent to the following amendment to the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement:

- 2.1.1. In paragraph 13.6. of Article XIII (Amendment, Termination, Entry Into Force, and Duration) of the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement, delete “fifteen (15) years” and insert in its place “thirty (30) years”.
- 2.2. All other terms and conditions of the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement remain unchanged.

ARTICLE III ENTRY INTO FORCE

- 3.1. This Amendment One to the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement shall enter into force upon signature by the Parties and shall remain in force for the same duration as the Colombia-U.S. Master Information Exchange Agreement.



PREÁMBULO

El Departamento de Defensa de los Estados Unidos de América y el Ministerio de Defensa Nacional de la República de Colombia, en adelante denominados las "Partes";

Considerando el Acuerdo entre el Departamento de Defensa de los Estados Unidos de América en relación con el intercambio de información sobre investigación y desarrollo (Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos), que entró en vigor el 21 de julio de 2009 y que permanecerá vigente hasta el 20 de julio de 2024;

Han llegado a los siguientes entendimientos:

ARTÍCULO I OBJETO

1.1. El objeto de esta Enmienda uno al Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos es extender la duración del Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos por quince (15) años hasta el 20 de julio de 2039.

ARTÍCULO II ENMIENDA

2.1. De conformidad con el párrafo 13.6. del Artículo XIII (Enmienda, rescisión, entrada en vigor y duración) del Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos, las Partes han consultado y por la presente consienten la siguiente enmienda al del Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos:

- 2.1.1. En el párrafo 13.6. del Artículo XIII (Enmienda, rescisión, entrada en vigor y duración) del Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos, suprimir “quince (15) años” e insertar en su lugar “treinta (30) años”.
- 2.2. Todos los demás términos y condiciones del Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos permanecen sin cambios.

ARTÍCULO III ENTRADA EN VIGOR

3.1. Esta Enmienda uno al Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos entrará en vigor a partir de la firma de las Partes y permanecerá vigente por la misma duración que el Acuerdo maestro de intercambio de información entre Colombia y los Estados Unidos.
